<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>"Ten to fifteen percent of cases of extrapulmonary tuberculosis (TB) are associated with the central nervous system (CNS)[1]." - This sentence can be re-phrased as Central nervous system forms 10 to 15 % of extra-pulmonary sites of tuberculosis.</p> <p>The manifestations should be enumerated depending on their incidence, for e.g. meningitis should be the first manifestation of CNS tuberculosis</p> <p>Major part of the introduction reads like the discussion where the patient's details are mentioned.</p> <p>All grammatical mistakes in the Case report has to be corrected too many to be individually enumerated</p> <p>The discussion also should follow a certain sequence like occurrences of tuberculomas in the CNS, their common sites, pathogenesis, differential diagnoses, and modes of presentation. This should be followed by the discussion of the case presented.</p> <p>The major concern is absence of pathology Images.</p>
