

Editor's Comment:

This is an interesting case report related to the thrombus within the heart. Most of the time, the thrombus arises from pathology in the lower limbs as deep venous thrombosis. Otherwise, they are formed in situ, which can lead to serious complications such as Pulmonary embolism (PE). These conditions require urgent anticoagulation therapy, which is essential to improve prognosis. The therapeutic strategy is based on the thrombus type, patient history, hemorrhagic risk, and the availability of different techniques to extract the thrombus. such as the endovascular techniques, which could be used in patients contraindicated for thrombolysis and surgery

This case report gives an insight on the management of the right-sided thrombus which is an emergency to prevent pulmonary embolism. The information would be useful for the clinical physicians.
