The author has highlighted the research gap in the area and also the different findings in the area. Keywords <i>job less and job loss growth needs to be explained in the paper.</i> The research method used by the author is properly structured and represented systematically. The model is based on the theory of Okun's law and latter GDP is disaggregated into the three sectors. <i>In the Short Run ARDL Estimates (with disaggregated GDP) the impact of lagged period of industry and public expenditure is not included in the table, its inclusion will add more insight to the paper. Figure 1 is missing from the analysis.</i> The discussion and concluding remarks of the paper are clear and precise.
