Be consistent in the use of teacher in singular or plural form in your Literature review. <i>If the school structures set ups are arranged to support teachers are dysfunctional, teacher can lose hope and sense of professional responsibility actually they perform poorly in (Actually is informal, use academic style)</i></p> <p>Avoid vague language, and the use of static verbs (assume) you can deduce that the study showed what you want to claim. <i>This assumes that for teachers to manage school projects sustainably motivation to them should not be underestimated.</i> The use of the word 'carious' is not clear in your sentence.
