To do so, the author(s) have used a survey method to collect data and draw out their findings.</p> <p>Logically, one would prefer to see what experiential factors play an important role and how they impact the understanding and understanding of mitigation climate change.</p> <p>While the paper has made a good starting and an effort in doing so it falls short in a number of areas:</p> <p>(a) Number of grammatical errors is high and at places even the sentences do not mean anything.</p> <p>(b) While the data collection has been done based on the questionnaire, the same has not been shared in the paper and needs to be provided.</p> <p>(c) The statistical analysis that follows needs to be supported by graphs to prove and explain what has been provided in the text.</p> <p>(d) Analysis that has been done does not relate to real life conditions. It needs to show relevance to such real life conditions.</p> <p>(e) Even the discussion does not provide areas where the climate change mitigation behavior changes and how and what needs to be done to achieve greater and complete mitigation.</p> <p>(f) Some pin pointed questions are indicated in the script.</p>
