This manuscript explores the urgency and relevance of the role of students in the KKS program for the development of faith and piety among the young generation in rural areas. The authors effectively outline the various contributions that can be made by KKS students, the challenges they face, and the strategies that can be applied to achieve these goals. However, there are some major revisions that should be applied.

Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?	The subsections and structure of the manuscript are not appropriate. There should be a separate section for the participants and context; the author would do well to explain the study's context in detail to make readers more familiar with it. Additionally, the results section is too shallow, and the themes and codes are not clearly defined. The claims made must be supported by quotes from the scripts of the semi-structured interviews, observations, and documents. The number, gender, and age of the participants should be presented in the manuscript in the form of a table. Furthermore, the literature review could be more thorough, providing a comprehensive background and justification for the study.

The topic is original and addresses a significant gap in the existing literature, focusing on the unique challenges, dedication, and hard work of rural students. Despite the need for structural revisions, the foundational research and methodologies employed are solid and provide a valuable contribution to the field.
