Simplifying the presentation of price equilibrium and the number of international markets (export and import markets) in one panel may confuse the reader. For this reason, it is recommended to follow the source (Salvatore, 2020), describing it in three panels.</li> <li>2. The highly simplified technique of using Constant Market Share Analysis (CMSA) has dubious results. Suggestions for this can be found in the comments on the manuscript.</li> </ol> <p>There are inconsistencies in writing references:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Using author and year such as (Wardhani and Rahadian, 2021) on page 1. Elsewhere citations are numbered in the order in which they appear in the manuscript.</li> <li>2. Citations using numbers based on the order in which they appear in the manuscript are not checked carefully. After [9] it jumps straight to [17] and [10] is placed after [19]. Likewise, after [16] jumps to [20].</li> </ol> <p>Additional suggestions for references have been written in the comments in the manuscript.</p>	
<p><b>Minor</b> REVISION comments</p> <p>1. <b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b></p>	<p>This manuscript needs proofreading, there are still some typos and there is even a paragraph that has not been translated into English (still in Indonesian, section 2.5 p. 4).</p>
