<p>1. Abstract: There should not be a word like “possible” in the results and a word like “confirm” in the conclusion. Please, delete “possible” from results and write “suggest” instead of “confirm” in conclusion.</p> <p>2. - INTRODUCTION: There are some paragraphs appearing without references. Please add a reference for each paragraph of introduction.</p> <p>3. - Method: Please change the word to be Methods. You can also add the name of hospital instead of “our hospital”. Also, you can delete the repetition mentioned in aim of work like this sentence “The primary goal of our work was to evaluate the transfer of the antibodies across the placenta.”.</p> <p>4. - DISCUSSION: You must add study restrictions at the end of discussion, as follows:</p> <p>There are some limitations to the study, including that it did not look at the long-term effects of vaccines on newborns and mothers.
