This forward-looking approach provides a valuable framework for further investigation. 4. While the review discusses emotional and relational impacts, it could benefit from a deeper exploration of the specific mechanisms through which infertility affects psychological well-being. Detailed pathways linking infertility to mental health outcomes would enhance the understanding of these effects. 5. The discussion on cultural and social context is valuable, but the review would be strengthened by including more specific examples or case studies from various cultural backgrounds. This would provide a more nuanced understanding of how cultural differences influence the experience and management of infertility. 6. The review does not adequately address the limitations of the included studies. A more critical assessment of potential biases, methodological limitations, and the generalizability of the findings would improve the review's credibility and transparency. 7. While the review discusses various psychological interventions, it could benefit from a more detailed evaluation of their effectiveness. A comparative analysis of different intervention types, including their relative efficacy and applicability to different populations, would provide more actionable insights for practitioners and researchers.
