It properly reflects what the manuscript is all about. So, no revision is needed.</li> <li>The abstract is comprehensive but could benefit from minor revisions for clarity. For instance, it should clearly state the main findings and implications of the review. Including specific results and their significance can make the abstract more informative.</li> <li>The structure of the manuscript is appropriate. However, the theoretical framework section is somewhat repetitive. The introduction and theoretical framework could be merged to avoid redundancy. This would streamline the manuscript and improve readability.</li> <li>The manuscript is scientifically sound, but there are areas where the discussion could be more critical. For example, while the review includes various studies, it often does not critically evaluate the quality of the included studies or discuss the potential biases and limitations.</li> <li>The references are adequate.
