The study compressively identifies and analyses the problem of Human trafficking-emphasizing on girl child trafficking from an African setup citing the plight and fate of one actor- named <i>Efia</i> as noted by the study as among the main characters who have suffered from human trafficking. Please write your suggestions here.</b></p>	<p>There is need of deletion or insertion of key terms in the abstract – <b>please check the using track changes tool in the reviewed article.</b></p> <p>The introduction section is good and shows the significance of the study. However, there are <b>a lot of typographical, punctuation and grammatical mistakes</b> that need to be addressed <i>as pinpointed in the track changes sections.</i></p> <p>A thorough revision for language and grammar is necessary to improve the readability and clarity of the text in the entire manuscript.</p> <p>The abstract lacks the methods and materials used to collect data and also techniques used to analyze data. Additional results and recommendations are needed.</p>
