In the reproductive age group, the major factor contributing to miscarriage could be more closely related to chemical toxicity like alcohol consumption or smoking which highlights the importance of organic dependencies.

Yes If no significant relationship was found between maternal age and miscarriage risk, it could be due to the narrow age range selected in the simulation. Maternal age is a known risk factor for miscarriage so the age range should be broader. For instance, expanding the age range to include women over 35 or even 40 could help clarify the relationship, as advanced maternal age is often associated with higher miscarriage risk. You could write: "In the selected young age group, alcohol and smoking can be considered independent factors in miscarriage risk."
