Simplifying sentence structures and avoiding redundancy would enhance readability. For example:          "The persistent ASUU strikes in Nigeria have disrupted school academic, left academic activities of universities disjointed, and distracted the normal learning process" could be rephrased to "Persistent ASUU strikes in Nigeria have disrupted academic activities, leaving universities disjointed and affecting learning processes."</p>
