In other words, Liquid Crystal Display should be written, and it should not be written (LCD), as this increases the strength of the search.</b>

<p><b>Optional/General</b> comments</p>	<p>1- References must be mentioned at the end of each paragraph in the introduction, where it is written like this [1] according to the journal's template method</p> <p>Or the author's name can be mentioned at the beginning of the paragraph and not at the end between brackets, as this makes the reader confused.</p> <p>2- A brief paragraph must be written at the end of the introduction section about the research and what it will present briefly in a paragraph not exceeding three or four lines.</p> <p>3- The main contributions of the research must be mentioned. The author must mention the extent of the contributions that the research provides to science and the scientific community and the extent of the expected impact. Why is it better than other methods? What are the advantages and disadvantages of other methods in brief?</p> <p>11- The contributions of this manuscript should be strongly indicated?</p> <p>12- A more detailed explanation should be provided in three or four lines on Table No. 2.</p> <p>13- In the (Decision) section, a table should be made showing the difference between the proposed device and similar devices in previous studies and research. This table should clarify the difference between the proposed system and other similar systems in terms of design, design complexity, measurement accuracy, number of cases on which the device was tested, and speed of response to display the results. The total cost of the proposed device should be mentioned and compared to other similar systems.</p> <p>14- The conclusions section can be presented more strongly to show the strength and contribution of the research to the scientific community.</p>
