Finally, the abstract should briefly hint at practical recommendations, such as the importance of professional development programs for teachers, to make the study's findings more actionable for educational stakeholders. Below are detailed observations and suggestions:</p> <p>Grammar and Syntax: Some sentences are overly complex or fragmented. For instance, "It is the fact that teachers are not paid enough, when they have less wages they will feel less motivated," could be rephrased for conciseness and grammatical correctness.</p> <p>Precision and Conciseness: Sentences like "Students are watchful and observant enough to notice and respond to that behavior" could be shortened to "Students observe and respond to teacher behavior," making the text more precise and formal.</p>
