It is ok but needs rephrasing and the English language needs to be improved moreover the abbreviations needs to be mentioned like Blood Urea Nitrogen (BUN) etc. Please write dosages 2 ml/100g as '2 mL/100g.' Use correct SI units.	
Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.	It is ok but authors haven't compared it with any significant research, there was no critical analysis. Please add more keywords. Make sure species names are italicized everywhere in the manuscript.

Also please follow the correct format for the references, the journal names are written in full at times while in some places they are abbreviated.

At this stage it needs a lot of work, words and spellings should be checked for example Petri Plate should be Petri plate check small grammatical mistakes. Check where the letters need to be capitalized and where small letters should be written. Also check your font size and the headings need to be checked as well. Authors can add more figures showing the experiments which would enhance the manuscript. Check for correct SI units throughout the manuscript. The authors should expand the discussion and conclusion.
