The article is great, but there are some parts which need to be improved. First, the researchers have found that there are many published articles related to the AI. However, it's much better to present the different areas by using the AI, such as digital health, marketing, computer sciences, etc. Second, the researchers should be clear about the maps which shown in the paper. For instance, the figure 23, 34 should show the countries' name on the map. Third, before your methodology, you should present the Prisma Flowchart, which is easy for other researchers to understand your work. Fourth, you should consider the year of 2024, because we still have 3 months to finish this year which means it will still have some articles published in this year. But your article is talking about the year range from 2019 to 2024, how did you define this? Fifth, in figure 30, you should define the schools of Co-occurrence Network. For example, for you blue spot, you can use digital health to represent this part. Last, for overall, you need to improve your English grammar.
