If the paper mentions about the region it is pertaining to and analyses case studies from the region, it would be of greater social importance since challenges and community participation differs from region to region.

For example, instead of "Building Inclusive Growth Frameworks Through Strategic Community Engagement in Energy Infrastructure Development Projects", the title could be restructured like: <b>"Building Inclusive Growth Frameworks in (A Particular Region): Significance of Strategic Community in Energy Infrastructure Development"</b>

For example, <b>the paper analyses strategic community engagement in the Global South with special reference to West Bengal since it houses a significant number of indigenous communities.</b> Mention of case studies is important. A research question in the abstract would strengthen the analysis. For example, <b>In which ways does community engagement facilitate inclusive growth in.....? What are the challenges?</b>

<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The paper highlighting _____. However, some major alterations need to be made. The author needs to specify <b>which region they are focusing on. For example, is it the Global South? If so, which country/state/province?</b> In that case, the region's topography and ethnography needs to be explained. Suitable case studies should also be analyse which would strengthen the author's arguments. This is because the concepts and ideas of _____ are relative and highly differ from region to region. So, instead of giving a broad analysis, the author should narrow down their arguments to a particular region by defining and analysing concepts like _____. Under <b>Heading 2.1</b> , suitable examples with respect to a region should be given as a justification of the author's arguments. Similarly, under <b>Heading 4.2</b> , the author needs to explain what they mean while speaking of 'environmental degradation' and cite examples. Thus, what the author, in total, needs to do is that link their propositions with a particular region, analyse the case studies and link every argument with suitable examples from a region. Or the <b>author can make a comparative study of the policy frameworks between two or more regions by analysing the above-mentioned points. Mention the names of indigenous communities of the particular region and their roles in energy infrastructure development. A brief description could also made of renewable energy projects in the Global North or South, as the case maybe.</b>
