However, additional information is required to strengthen this manuscript, and revisions to the title and some parts of the case presentation may be necessary. Specifically, the following details should be addressed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The intraocular pressure (IOP) status of the patient before and after treatment. 2. Vitreous findings: Given that vitritis is commonly associated with Lyme uveitis, this should be mentioned in the manuscript if present. If vitritis is confirmed, the title should be updated to 'Pan-uveitis' to reflect this.
