It emphasises the transformation in learning, teaching, and preschool education, which is significant given the rise of AI in education. The discussion is timely and aligns with global efforts to adapt educational ecosystems to emerging technologies.

Please write your suggestions here.</p>	<p>The Abstract is comprehensive but needs a lot of work to do The grammar of the script is too confusing No purpose of the study is mentioned anywhere No scholarly wording has been used. Remove vague phrases like "take the best and discard the dross" for scholarly clarity. Reorganize the abstract to present the objective, key insights, and implications concisely</p>	
<p>Is the manuscript scientifically, correct? Please write here.</p>	<p>The manuscript raises important points but lacks the empirical evidence and depth required to substantiate some of its key claims. While the ideas are thought-provoking, several claims are either speculative or need further elaboration and validation. In section 1.1, the manuscript states: <i>"Students immersed in short-term, superficial learning fail to develop deeper theoretical thinking abilities, leading to a potential decline and obscuring of creativity."</i> This is an important concern but is presented without supporting empirical data or references to existing studies showing how ChatGPT specifically impacts creativity and theoretical thinking in education. in section 1.3, <i>"ChatGPT aids students in becoming self-educators, prompts teachers to become reflective educators, and ChatGPT itself evolves into an institutionalized educator within school education."</i> While this is a visionary idea, there is no discussion of how this transformation could occur practically, nor is there evidence supporting this trajectory. Section 2.1 mentions: <i>"When people use ChatGPT for dialogue and communication, they may unconsciously be influenced by the patterns and templates behind the robot."</i> This observation is significant but remains underexplored. It does not address specific risks, such as cognitive homogenization or dependency on AI tools, which could hinder students' critical thinking abilities. Expand this discussion with references to studies on the psychological and cognitive impacts of AI tools on learners. section 2.2, the manuscript states: <i>"Artificial intelligence liberates humans from the use of tools, and each iteration and update of AI brings about the elimination of repetitive and simple physical labor."</i> This overlooks significant ethical challenges, such as data privacy in AI-powered education and potential biases in AI-generated content. <i>include a deeper analysis.</i> The manuscript lacks empirical studies or real-world examples to substantiate its claims about ChatGPT's benefits and risks. The speculative nature of many arguments weakens the scientific robustness of the manuscript. Ethical considerations are mentioned but not explored in depth.</p>	
<p>Are the references sufficient and recent? If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form.</p>	<p>References are adequate but overly reliant on a single source (Reference 1). Additionally, the formatting is inconsistent. Some references are written in Times New Roman and Some are in Calibri font also font size is not consistent.</p>	
<p>Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>The language requires significant editing for clarity and a scholarly tone. a lot of Grammar mistakes and a lack of consistent scholarly tone, need to revise and simplify the language, too complex.</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>The manuscript's breadth makes it unfocused at times. Narrowing the scope to specific areas, such as preschool education or teacher professional development, could strengthen the discussion.</p> <p>The use of AI tools is suspected.</p>
