However, it would be clearer if the statistical results were presented more explicitly, such as mentioning specific statistical values or highlighting which educational practices were found to have a significant relationship with academic performance.

The use of a descriptive-correlational method is appropriate for the research questions posed, and the subsections on methodology, results, and discussion are thorough.
