It is not to say that not appropriate to have the study done as to just signify the importance of the laboratory studies and seeing the patient with COVID-19. However, to compare with control would be appropriate, and it would be to depict the importance of a different mechanisms provided in the laboratory studies, which could or could not signify the importance.
