

Editor's Comment:

The paper can be accepted for publication, only after some changes:

- The Abstract is too long, must be reduced. In Abstract the authors have to mention the objective of the paper, the methodology used and the expected results
- The Literature review section can be improved with references to more papers in the field
- The Conclusion section is not a Conclusion section, but results and discussion. And regarding Recommendations section I suggest to write in phrases, fluent from one idea to the next idea, not so schematically.
- And the authors do not mention the limitation of the paper, as suggested by reviewers.

Also, I'd like to ask the Editor to require to the authors when submitting revised versions to use "track changes" or to highlight the text.
