I have checked the revised paper,

It is well written.

But I found two points which may be corrected or checked by the authors before publication.

Page 3, in the last paragraph, it is written,

"He brings up his two sons and a daughter inculcating human values. 'Unfortunately', his younger son, Girish could inherit the values of life taught by his father."

I am wondering whether 'Unfortunately' is correct or not.

It should be rather written as 'Fortunately', if the authors (or Sudha Murty) believes simple life is best.

Please check it.

Page 5, in the fourth paragraph

'IIT conpany' should be corrected as 'IT company'.
