

Editor's Comment:

I have carefully read the manuscript, as well as the reviewers' comments. **The study is interesting, and could be published**, provided that the Authors are ready to carry a deep revision work on. There are a high number of typing errors. See for example Ipomea for Ipomoea in the title, and Ipomia as a keyword; Geimsa for Giemsa; anastaeized for anesthetized, and so on. What do the Authors mean for "ammonium"? Perhaps ammonia? Please explain. The correct execution of the Folin-Ciocalteu assay for phenolics is different from that described by the Authors that moreover have spelled incorrectly "Ciocalteau" for "Ciocalteu". **On the whole, typing and punctuation require a compulsory deep check to make the manuscript suitable for publication.**
