

Editor's Comment:

I have now had a look at the submitted paper. This study reports the results of a local questionnaire survey in Nigeria.

On the whole, it is OK but there are the following minor issues:

- Abstract: Yamane's formula: word "formula" missing
- P.3, bottom line, "his best" should be gendered "his/her best", there were also female respondents
- P.4, second para: "are been driven" should read "are driven"
- P.5, pursuit their vision: "pursuit of their vision"
- P.5, "for which the driving force is perception" ("for" missing)
- P.5 "it is a fact that some university students want and believe" (omit "why")
- P.5 last sentence "In addition, ..." incomplete sentence
- P.6 paragraph "The study, ..." sentence incomprehensible
- P.9 "while the remaining 21.40%" delete "while"
- P.12 "indicate that self-development" delete "that"
- P.12 Discussion of findings: "entrepreneurship is significant " should read "entrepreneurship is more significant"
- P.12 last para "there is no significant relationship" should read "there is no relationship" (important change: hypotheses should not contain significance statements)
- P.13 "self-development and perception are less significant" should read "self-development and perception both play a role"
- P.13 "the study indicated that" delete "that"
