The review is a narrative about what has been already published and generally accepted. The selection of articles used for this review is based on my objective knowledge of the subject and the assumptions are mine. However, I have backed these with a current and comprehensive reference list. Almost every statement in the manuscript is referenced. It is not a systemic review, which would involve a massive increase in research, nor a meta-analysis which is even more exhaustive and in addition, would require statistical methods to be employed.
