<p>I am sometimes confused with the explanation for comparing between students of majoring business English and those of all majors.</p> <p>For example, in Page 8, in the fourth paragraph, it is written, "Among factors that promote extracurricular reading, teachers rank the top, that is, 23.61% of students believe..."</p> <p>I am at first confused and later understood the explanation, only after I checked the Appendix Table 3, as follows</p> <p>"Among factors that promote extracurricular reading, teachers rank the top, that is, 23.61% of students (who major business English) believe..."</p> <p>Or in Page 9, the first paragraph, it is written, "about one third of students choose to read foreign literary masterpieces (i.e. 34.72%) and modern and contemporary Chinese literature (i.e. 30.56%), which are similar to the reading hobbies of students of all majors of the university (i.e.28.35% and 37.44% respectively). "</p> <p>I am also confused and later understood the explanation, only after I checked the Appendix Table 26, as follows</p> <p>"about one third of students (who major business English) choose to read foreign literary masterpieces (i.e. 34.72%) and modern and contemporary Chinese literature (i.e. 30.56%),..."</p> <p>Please explicitly explain and compare student of "business English majors" and "all majors" in each explanation.</p> <p>The authors should refer each of appendix tables or insert them in the text, for more readability.</p>	<p>Yes, thank you for reminding me of this confusion.</p> <p>Most of my statements come from or are based on the survey results, which, therefore, will be frequently referred to in the article.</p> <p>And this may cause reader's confusion if without relevant table insertion or indicators in the text.</p> <p>Now, I have inserted some relevant tables, and indicators following relevant statement, referring to related questions in the questionnaire appended.</p> <p>Thank you very much again.</p>
