First, it seems quite focused on Nigeria, but neither the title nor abstract indicates this focus. Authors should clarify this as well as objective of report. See track changes</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Check edits to accept and/or complete the '...' including to develop short statements of objective and research method 2. In-text citation and the associated reference list is full of errors. Some have been highlighted in yellow, but authors should check everything 3. The reference to "National Primary Health Care Development Agency (2021)" seems to be the main data source reviewed in this report i.e. considering the conclusion. Thus, it is important that the reference is complete and accessible. Authors have cited 'facebook' and 'twitter' sources. While social media is allowed, authors should one of the following – re: either <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. consult reference libraries such as Endnote or Mendeley to complete the necessary information, OR b. look up more traditional sources such as government papers, newspapers, etc <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i.
