Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>In the present manuscript, the authors examined the phytochemical and pasty properties of weaning foods based on cereals, legumes, and vegetables. The authors determined that the addition of fermented corn and defatted soybeans to weaning feeds may increase the digestibility of the mixes, but reduces the content of antinutrients, particularly tannins and flavonoids, and increases pasty properties, such as peak viscosity. It was also observed that the inclusion of carrot powder contributes to increasing the amount of vitamin A. The study is interesting because of the serious disorders that protein-energy malnutrition causes in children, particularly in developing countries, and the need to find formulations that incorporate local resources and promote sustainable development. In my opinion, the work is clearly structured and developed in detail.
