Minor REVISION comments	<p>This article provides important information regarding the nutritional value of malted Sorghum and <i>Moringa olifera</i> flour blends, in the context in which current global food concerns are directed towards product quality, diversification of production and renewal of the product range, thus aiming to obtain products with high nutritional value, without additives, preservatives or other compounds with a negative impact on the human body. <i>Moringa olifera</i> flour has shown higher nutritional superiority when compared to sorghum flour, being important source of nutrients: protein, fibre, mineral and fat. The Introduction gives a suitable description of the addressed problem and it shows the significance of the research problem. However, some minor corrections should be made in order to publish the article.</p> <p>Please, take into account the following recommendations to improve this manuscript:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the general presentation of the manuscript should be reviewed, the extra spaces between words or the lack of spaces between titles, subtitles, figures, tables and text according to the requirements of the journal; - bibliographic references 4, 5 and 6 are not found in the text; - the Introduction of the study is fragile, it does not include those sources (materials, reports, publications etc.) which offers a direct treatment of the subject to research (a comprehensive review published on the nutritional profile of the <i>Moringa olifera</i> flour; - full insertion of tables in text on a single page (see tables 4 and 5, pages 18 and 20); - I recommend a revision of the manuscript according to the requirements of the journal (English, technical editing, bibliography, etc.); - The title of the manuscript is "QUALITY EVALUATION OF GRUELS FROM MALTED SORGHUM- MORINGA OLIFERA FLOUR BLENDS", but in the content of the manuscript there is no nutritional and phytochemical profile of Gruels, except that of the two studied flours. In this sense, I recommend adapting the title to the content of the manuscript; - A clearer presentation of the methods used to determine the vitamins in the flour mixtures studied - I recommend unitary editing of figures and tables (they are edited with TNR and the text of the manuscript with Arial); - I recommend unitary editing of bibliographic references (they are edited with Calibri and the text of the manuscript with Arial). <p>I recommend a carefully check of the full manuscript in order to correct any grammatical or syntax errors. Based on the above mentioned, I recommend this paper for publication after performing the suggested corrections.</p>
