<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	While this article is interesting, it doesn't appear to be publishable without major revision. The method section does not clearly describe the procedures and the result section is too thin. No spectral and chromatographic data were shown which is required for any chemical analysis. The dose response graph doesn't seem to be right because it usually is a sigmoidal curve. In addition, I am not familiar with the mechanism of snake bite treatment and can not judge the correctness of the conclusion. A second reviewer may be needed in this case.
