Really a very important, sensitive and influential topic because the level of ambition among young people is positively reflected, whether in terms of agricultural development or managing economic projects and future innovations..</p> <p>The way the topic was presented was smooth and clear, but it lacked some small details to be complete as required.</p> <p>Individuals' personal plans are related to a network of material and cultural factors, and the natural disasters that farmers are exposed to are among the most important reasons for the destruction of agricultural ambition and future aspirations for them. Therefore, special attention must be paid in order to support and encourage ambition and future plans and mitigate the negative effects of these disasters through social security and support peasants .</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p>	<p>Agricultural ambition is not limited to males, so I suggest adding a paragraph explaining the agricultural ambition of women and their ideas for agricultural development and project management (Pachauri , 2019) especially individuals who migrate from the countryside to the cities to get better job opportunities, leaving females to manage agricultural activities and projects, so there is always a need to understand the challenges and barriers that women face. And the development of these ideas and aspirations for agricultural development. Also ,</p> <p>More than 400 million women around the world participate in agricultural projects, despite not having equal rights with men (World Bank 2017) .</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>I suggest adding a paragraph about the importance of ambition in the agricultural and economic development of countries, as a number of researches in Pakistan and Ethiopia have shown that the importance of ambition and self-development lies in the ability of people to engage in agricultural behavior of huge benefit that reflected in the family and society (Kosec and Mo 2017)..</p>
