The title should be revised to “ Case study of COVID19 vaccine-associated Myocarditis “ , which can better reflect the topic. The original title will mislead readers to think the Myocarditis was induced by COVID-19 infection directly. 2. During the disease course, did the patinte have any COVID-19 test (antigen or antibody) ?. if any, should be included. 3. The weak part is the discussion. Author put all effect on various causes of myocarditis, contrasting diagnostic approaches, prognosis, and management guidelines. But failed to build the association with the COVID-19 vaccine with myocarditis. 4. There are many case reports regarding COVID-19 vaccine-induced myocarditis. However, author did not cite these reports 5. Many references needed to be revised: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5.1 Many ref cited were around 2006, 2007, two refs were from 1997. These should be updated. 5.2 Ref15, 16, incomplete
