Is there any available data regarding the follow-up?</p> <p>The Discussion should include a comparison to the anatomical resections (results, benefits). The section regarding the margin of resection for liver metastases can be expanded. R1 vascular citation (nr 13) is related to cholangiocarcinoma.</p> <p>The references should be more updated.</p>
