Also enlist the sea grass species significant as the breeding ground of siganids or "samaral", corals of different size and shapes. The islands are also abode of different wildlife like thousands of monkeys and fruit bats. Moreover, the crystal clear waters teem with varied fish species, crabs, and sea urchins as well as wild birds and eagles. It would be interesting to know the role of the plantations in enriching the biodiversity of the islands. What is the positive and negative impact of the eco-tourism on the biodiversity resources? Each project objectives should be statistically represented with post-implementation data, a Project Success Model and critical success factors for the women community-driven initiatives for biodiversity conservation.
