Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The article presented for review makes a detailed description of the training in several educational institutions, dictated by the current epidemic circumstances. The author has done extensive research on the literature on Generation Z habits and e-learning trends. Approaches to learning in electronic environments are described, as well as methods for stimulating students (creative learning, interactivity, motivation). A good concrete study of situations by real institutions has been made, which is described in detail.</p> <p>The main remarks are a few facts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the results of the study would be much clearer if they were graphically visualized. - when presenting the training models (problem-based learning model and project-based learning model), the author should do a brief discussion of which of the two models is more advisable to increase the attractiveness of learning. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - it would be good if the author briefly describes what strategy and methodology of the training model is recommended - emphasis on attractive teaching methods, such as learning through games and the use of multimedia techniques in teaching 	
Optional/General comments	<p>In general, the article is well written, sufficient research has been done and it objectively presents the current situation in the region. Recommendations can be made for methods to increase teachers' digital competences.</p>
