Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>There is an inconsistency of apostrophes used throughout the article. For example, in the abstract, line 14, it shows– students“. Meanwhile, page 3, the third paragraph, line 3, shows students'. It would be better if the author made some amendments.</p> <p>Page 8, the second paragraph, last line: <i>“To me, quality learning environment encompasses the availability of teaching and learning materials including textbooks, teaching and learning aids which facilitate effective teaching and learning process, without them, there is quality learning environment”</i>. The sentence does not seem to be entirely logical. The first of the sentence claimed that a quality learning environment encompasses teaching and learning materials; the last part mentioned: “without them, there is quality learning environment”. The sentence seems to be contradicted. Perhaps the author can revise it.</p> <p>Page 2, last paragraph, line 4 “introduction.....” the gaps between each alphabet seem bigger than the others in the article. The same goes with page 9, first paragraph, line 8.</p> <p>Page 9, Part 4.2.1, line 10, spelling mistake “masterly”, should be “mastery”.</p> <p>Page 10, Part 4.2.3, first paragraph, line 5, spelling mistake “hopping”, should be “hoping”</p> <p>Page 14, part 5, line 11, “fit in a day-day life”, the author might want to revise it.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Perhaps the author can include some recent references as citations as some of the references are more than ten years and above.</p> <p>Since the author discussed participatory methods in Part 4, the author might briefly explain this teaching method in Part 2 to give readers some ideas about the participatory approach.</p>	
Optional/General comments	<p>Overall, this is a good article that provides readers with the teaching and learning situations in secondary schools in Tanzania. It clearly shows how the research is conducted and the factors that influence teaching and learning in secondary schools are identified and well discussed.</p>
