Just a few changes in language are recommended; for instance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - "perhaps, the differences in the findings" → It can hypothesized that the differences in the findings - "but with other studies" → but also by other studies - "available online, such as from "Student Experience" → available online, such as "Student Experience - "perhaps, that explains why they are" → could explain why they are - "academic use [17], perhaps, innovative projects" → academic use [17], innovative projects - "suspended. Suspended in the sense that they are" → suspended. In this case, the term "suspended" alludes to the fact that they are - "context are not that very much affected" → context are not very much affected - "in all areas, innumerably, content" → the meaning of the term innumerably in this context is not clear.
