Examples of metabolic disorders associated with OA include hypertension and diabetes mellitus</p> <p>The authors cited only the association of secondary osteoarthritis and hypertension, but there is in the article that the authors cite the statement that diabetes mellitus is also associated with osteoarthritis: "<i>Examples of metabolic disorders associated with OA include hypertension and diabetes mellitus</i>".</p> <p>In addition, there are several studies that prove the association of diabetes and osteoarthritis, for example:            Nieves_Plaza et al (2013) – J Clin Rheumatol 2013            Schett G et al (2013) - Diabetes Care 2013; 36:403–409            Piva SR et al (2015) - Clin Geriatr Med. 2015 February ; 31(1): 67–87</p> <p>2.
