Because line of management might affect the functional scores.3) Civilian scores was achieved from where? Any reference? No citation given for civilian scores.	
Minor REVISION comments	Time since injury also needs to be considered in the study. There might be some cases having a fresh injury and some might be few years old. This discrepancy can affect the functional score. Study needs this consideration.
