After a similarity analysis, using the "Plagius" software, a similarity to tests published on the internet was detected above 70%, values well above acceptable similarity indices. I suggest that authors use similarity software to review and reduce the similarities of the current version.	
Minor REVISION comments		
Optional/General comments	The main source of similarity between the paper and material already published is detected in the "Background" (85%). Considering that the results are from the authors and have not yet been published, the similarity problem can be easily solved by rewriting the text of the paper.
