Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Abstract & text:</p> <p>- Materials and Methods:</p> <p>. (mention the manufacturer) . What type of serological tests was made? (mention manufacturer) (in the abstract)</p> <p>Results :</p> <p>- For table 2, the commentary is not clear enough, the reader cannot understand if serological tests were made regulatory for all patients after each month, or if the authors did such tests in the different months to the number of patients mentioned. The explicative text must be more precise.</p> <p>- "Even patients' sample is little" you must mention the p value for statistical study, so that the reader can be sure of the statistical significance.</p> <p>- Authors should underline with an appropriate figure the evolution of IgG antibodies over time.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>- COVID-19 not COVID 19 or covid-19 (maintain the same writing). - It is better to write the number and percentage in words than in numbers at the beginning of sentences. - The citation of figures and tables must be mentioned in the text before their presentation.</p> <p>Discussion:</p> <p>- We couldn't find any association between fever and antibody response- No significant association was seen between symptoms and antibody response (this type of conclusion is not appropriate to be mentioned). - Mention only the name of the author followed by et al. - Other minor corrections are made in red colour directly in the text.</p> <p>Conclusion:</p> <p>"and chances of natural immunity is less", rewrite the sentence to make it more understandable.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>According to the international nomenclature, authors' identification must be: the name and first letter of the forname of the six first authors, and beyond, you have to mention "et al" .</p>	
Optional/General comments	Expand the discussion a bit more, emphasizing the particularities of the immune response to Sars-Cov-2
