<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>1. The paper is a very basic paper checking only the antimicrobial activity. Generally all plant extracts will have this activity. Also, the media preparation for checking the antimicrobial activity is not specifically elaborated. It would have been good if the author is able to specify which phytochemical has major activity against the UTI pathogen.</p> <p>2. Also, the CHROMagar™ Orientation is a commercially available media for detecting the pathogens in UTI. Then why there is a need for biochemical test? Adequate literature is available to describe UTI pathogens. There is no significance in performing identification procedure.</p> <p>3. What is the need of statistical analysis? It has to be performed only if the number of sample exceeds 10 or above. Here the author has not mentioned how many samples they have taken for analysis?</p>
