Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>There are three levels of education listed: Diploma, BSN, and MSN. The same survey is given to all three groups. There is a major technical issue here. In many countries/regions, nurses are trained at different levels. Each nurse performs nursing skills per their level of education.</p> <p>For example, a Diploma nurse performs more basic skills such as feeding, providing comfort measures, etc. An advanced level nurse spends more time performing advanced nursing skills and less time on feeding, documenting I & O, etc.</p> <p>Therefore, there is a problem with design of this study. Therefore, the author needs to clearly states that the three levels of nursing education in Rwanda prepare nurses to perform the exact same nursing skills on a daily basis which does not seem to be logical.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Change: Nurse Related Factors to Demographic data Write out the numbers or use numbers itself, but do not include number in parenthesis. Use N= or n= to show the number of participants Replying → responding</p> <p>Why the percentage of “married” participants is included? Is this related to the level of care provided?
