<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The abstract has no "background/introduction". This should come before the "Aim of study".</li> <li>Under "introduction", the 21<sup>st</sup> line of the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph has the word "in vitro" that is not italicised.</li> <li>In the 5<sup>th</sup> line of the abstract (2<sup>nd</sup> line of the methodology), a "comma" is more suitable than the "full stop" punctuation. That is, "...were collected, washed and air-dried" instead of "... were collected. Washed and air – dried".</li> </ul>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	References recognized by google scholar is more preferable especially in cases where there is an alternative recognized citation. Reference 1 may not be standard.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	Even though previous research had indicated the phytochemicals present in the plant in general, knowing the phytochemicals present in each solvent extract would give more insight to the cause/reason of their activity and this could be linked to result of other findings in the discussion section.
