The national context is presented relatively late in Chapter 2 Environment. It is recommended to insert this in the introduction, at least to some extent. Especially in the case of general statements, such as in the introduction, it is strongly recommended to back them up with the help of quotations. This would also strengthen the number of references and the framework of the work.

Optional/General comments	<p>The article begins with the abstract, which summarizes the most important information about the presented article. The objective, the study design, location and duration of the study, methodology, results and output are discussed. The introduction begins with statements that can be evaluated as subjective to the reader. It is strongly recommended to use literature and citations to adapt the contribution to scientific standards. Because in the European context there are cases in which there is a conscious decision for children with disabilities that result from prenatal diagnostics. Therefore, the substantiation of these statements is very important. Your own assumptions are presented. The state of research is presented using selected studies. Why these studies are consulted remains open and should be presented more systematically. The research focus with corresponding questions and hypotheses are brought into focus in the corresponding chapter. The Material and Methods chapter contains the research design, the national context (which could be named as such for readability), participants, sampling design instrument, data gathering procedures and statistical treatment of data.</p> <p>The third chapter is devoted to the results and discussion.
