The English need improvement since there are few grammatical and syntax errors in the manuscript For example, the words “an significant” may be as “a significant”; “which belongs” as “that belongs”; “Joint” as “the Joint”; “genotoxic” as “the genotoxic”; “Whole-blood” as “A whole-blood”; “a positive” as “positive”; “with of SY” as “with SY”; “organic” as “an organic”; “highly” as “the highly”; “quinoline” as “are quinoline”; “the of” as “the”. The grammar mistakes which are not mentioned here also to be checked and corrected properly.</p> <p>2. There are some typing mistakes as well, and authors are advised to carefully proof-read the text For example, the words “each treatments” may be as “each treatment”; “t test” as “t-test”; “Different type” as “Different types”; “after treated” as “after treatment”; “which used” as “used”; “and drug” as “and drugs”; “tow” as “two”; “types of” as “type of”; “this azo” as “these azo”; “use products” as “used products”. The typos not mentioned here also to be checked and corrected properly.</p> <p>3. In the statistical analysis the authors should include a software with version of the software used in the present findings under the heading “Statistical Data Analysis”. If the authors refer to SPSS versions beginning from 19, authors should cite 'IBM SPSS Statistics for Windows, version XX (IBM Corp., Armonk, N.Y., USA)'.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>1. Check the abbreviations throughout the manuscript and introduce the abbreviation when the full word appears the first time in the text and then use only the abbreviation (For example, Sunset yellow (SY), etc.). And it should be in both abstract as well as in the remaining part of the manuscript. Make a word abbreviated in the article that is repeated at least three times in the text, not all words need to be abbreviated.</p> <p>2. The technical terms (Latin Phrase) “in vitro and in vivo” should be italic and it should be checked all over the manuscript.</p>	
Optional/General comments	<p>The authors have put effort to evaluate the “In Vitro Effects of Sunset Yellow on Chromosomal Damage and Sister Chromatid Exchange in Human Peripheral Lymphocytes”. The authors describe the research undertaken with this in an organized manner, emphasizing the results obtained by them. The article needs modification for better cohesion of information to achieve the goal and the minor shortcomings which need to be considered. Hence, the paper can be accepted after MINOR REVISIONS are carried out.</p>
