| <b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Being a review paper, I expect more references in the paper.</li> <li>• Although the paper follows the direction of qualitative research, more data (possibly charts) from existing research can be employed to support some of the claims made in the paper – this will improve the quality of paper.</li> <li>• The authors presented the COVID-19 outbreak as a key motivation for this paper. However, these were mentioned in the passing. More detailed reviews in this light will be necessary.</li> <li>• The paper lacked concrete examples of the nature of digital transformation Nigeria might need. I recommend that the authors review a few digital transformations in education such as “blended learning practised in the UK” and narrow this discussion down to how these could apply to Nigeria.</li> <li>• The paper did not elaborate how factors such as the Internet penetration, digital divide, lack of infrastructure, technological literacy, and so on can affect their proposal for digital transformation.</li> <li>• The paper contains little or nothing with respect to efforts of Nigerian government towards educational digital transformation in Nigeria</li> </ul> |   |
