<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>This work seems to be a continuation of a series of previous articles that follow the same line of study. In this sense, it seems reasonable to me to make some self-citations but not in excess. Too many self-citations, as is the case, make the manuscript references impoverished. Some need to be removed and replaced with other references.</p> <p>Besides, this manuscript is practically the same as the one entitled "On Size Evolution / Radiated Power of Extragalactic Radio Sources and Implication" where the EGRS study is developed. In the current one, the study of CSS sources is developed, but exactly the same references and the same Figure 1 as in the indicated article are used to describe different things. I think a change is needed in the references and a more detailed description of Figure 1 focused on the CSS sources.</p>
